SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN

As part of the Leisure Assistance and Family Relief programme, children and young people with developmental delays and/or disabilities are given the support they need to be able to enjoy the recreational activities they love and have an interest in.

Our services provide the opportunity for children and parents to rediscover and make use of their own freedom. Through the Leisure Assistance programme, we give families and carers a break from everyday life, allowing them time for recuperation and supporting the family environment.



WHO IS THE SERVICE FOR?

The Leisure Assistance & Family Relief programme may be used by children and young people aged 0 to 18 years and their families, provided they receive higher family allowance or a care allowance. In addition, it is possible to apply for holiday support for children, who go to kindergarten or school.

WHAT ACTIVITIES ARE AVAILABLE?

In conjunction with the child and parents, activities are chosen which are both fun for the child and offer relief for the family. Excursions, hiking, football, horse riding, playing in a playground, skiing, swimming, going to events and group games are just a few of the possibilities.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Leisure Assistance & Family Relief can take place in a familiar context at home or in the form of accompanying the child to various activities. The service is available all year round, even during holiday periods and on weekends.

WHO ACCOMPANIES THE CHILD?

We are guided by the interests of the child and the needs of the family. Whenever practicable, the leisure assistant is selected according to the type of activities the child wishes to do.

WHAT DOES THE SERVICE COST?

The number of hours approved by the Province of Tyrol for Leisure Assistance & Family Relief ranges from 40 to 376 hours per year and depends on the individual family situation. The out-of-pocket cost is based on the amount of care allowance.
